In 1990 Gary's role changed to manage the motion picture artifact collections at Disney's Hollywood Studios. During his time as Curator, Exhibit Producer, Gary cared for such film icons as the Rosebud sled from Citizen Kane, the Julie Andrews Jolly Holiday dress from the Disney classic Mary Poppins, the Maltese Falcon and the famed Ruby Slippers from The Wizard of Oz.

Today Gary leads the Show Awareness program at Imagineering, creating presentations and educational materials that document the fascinating world behind the creation of Disney Theme Parks, Resorts, Cruise Ships and Entertainment Complexes around the world.
