He is also a former chair of the TiLE Conference, founder of the TEA Summit, past president of the TEA – an international organization representing the creators of attractions, places, and events. His awards include the Cine Golden Eagle in both 1989 and 1990, the Houston International Film Festival Grand Prize for Short Films, and a 2003 THEA for Volkswagen's Gläserne Manufaktur in Dresden, Germany.
