



## **Steven Beattie Patrick** 1950 -2010

Memorial "Lovefest," Sunday July 11

Design engineer Steve Patrick, whose visionary work with Walt Disney Imagineering, Jet Propulsion Laboratory and his own company, Interactive Design Engineering, ranged from projects such as the Mars Rover to theme park rides to concert stage effects for performers Madonna, Michael Jackson and Paul McCartney, has died after a year-long battle with kidney cancer.

Under the mentorship of Walt Disney Company Legend Bob Gurr, Steve designed ride vehicles for Disney's EPCOT Center, then worked at Universal Studios, where he designed the simulator motion base for both "Back to the Future" and "Earthwuake LA." As a senior engineer with Walt Disney Imagineering he was instrumental in the development of theme park equipment, special effects and animatronics robots.

"The outstanding thing that everyone liked about Steve is he was always ready to do anything; his being there really made a difference," say Bob Gurr. "He had that basic attitude at Disney and in his own business. He was always learning new stuff; loved to pick up on anything new."

Steve was honored shortly after his death with a NASA Board Award for NTR no. 44144: "Subcritical Water Extraction Technology for Planetary Exploration," one more acknowledgement of his work in a long list of achievements spanning his career.

Steve is survived by his wife, Debbi Swanson Patrick, sons David and Christopher from his previous marriage to Mary Brown, mother Haruko Ouellette, sisters Angelique IIo and Trish Jacobs, as well as beloved aunts and uncles, nieces, nephews and cousins.

There will be a memorial (Steve's Lovefest) Sunday, July 11, Noon to 4 pm at Farnsworth Park, 568 E. Mount Curve Ave. (at Lake Ave.) Altadena, CA. In lieu of flowers, donations can be made in Steven Patrick's name to the Awareness Center in Pasadena via check or to the Southern California Hospice Foundation online.





#### Members in the News



Premier Rides' newest installation, the Sky Rocket at Kennywood Park, was successfully topped off by ironworkers last week. The final 70 foot section weighing over 80 tons was carefully installed ten stories up in the air at the highest point of the ride. Sky Rocket's magnetic launch technology makes this one of Kennywood's most exciting attractions, featuring three inversions, and a 0-80km/hr launch in 2 seconds. After the high speed launch riders will experience a vertical ascent to 95 feet before a brief pause at the top (read: cliffhanger) and a 90-degree drop into maximum G-force pullout. The riders will then enjoy extended airtime as the train races into an inverted top hat element, passes into a barrel roll, and goes vertical again through a twist up leading to another pause. A second vertical freefall follows, with another maximum G-force pullout on the way into a highly banked fan curve; then a twisted corkscrew, a curve to a zero gravity hill, and aseries of wave turns. 
