






#### Taylor Studios, Inc. at the National Museum of the Marine Corps

Taylor Studios, Inc. is completing work on exhibit installations in three new, large-scale galleries at the National Museum of the Marine Corps (opened June 5). With exhibits interpreting the legendary founding of the Corps in 1775, the Civil War, US global trade expansion in the 19th century, and World War I, Taylor Studios has been integral to bringing the new galleries to life.

The new exhibits will include an additional mmersive experience, for which the Museum has become world-reknowned. Visitors will enter a stretch of forest in Western France amidst the Battle of Belleau Wood, encountering a German machine gun nest. With the smell of cordite in the air and the sound of bullets whistling above their heads, visitors will experience the charge of the Marines across a wheat field, just as it happened on June 6, 1918. For thisproject, Taylor Studios created 12 highly realistic life-cast figures, all of the models portraying historic Marine figures were actually modern Marines. More info: www.taylorstudios.com

#### PLASA and ESTA Vote to Merge

PLASA (Professional Lighting and Sound Association), which represents specialists in professional audio, AV, lighting, rigging, staging and related technologies who work across a wide range of projects, from theatre, live music, film/TV and events to night venues, architectural installations and construction projects, and ESTA (Entertainment Services and Technology Association), the principal trade association for entertainment services and technologies in North America, have voted to merge their two organizations. The announcement comes on the back of lengthy consulttions with both sts of memberships. Well over 90% of members from each association voted in support of the merger, which will see PLASA and ESTA integrated to create a single international trade association operating under the PLASA name.

Both teams will now spend the next six months putting in place the infrastructure behind the merger, the first formal stage of which will be completed in December 2010, allowing the new organization to go live on 1 January, 2011. The new organization will represent some 1200 manufacturers, dealers, service providers and consultants working across the entertainment and installation indutries. This will also include members of PERA, the former ProductionEquipment Rental Association, which recently merged with PLASA. An overarching governing body will be established to look after the interests of the membership worldwide and to work closely with Regional Boards for North America and Europe.

In a joint statement, PLASA CEO Matthew Griffiths and ESTA Executive Director Lori Rubinstein said: "We believe the logic driving the merger is totally sound: the strengths of both organizations are evident and we have an unequalled opportunity to increase the value we provide to Members through services, networking and improved business opportunities. A united approach to the issues and challenges of our industry will provide major long-term benefits and greatly broaden the role of the PLASA."






